- 2ND – 1917 \$2 Jefferson note
- 3RD – 1899 \$1 Black Eagle silver certificate

CLASS 3 - TOKENS, MEDALS, ORDERS, DECORATIONS

- 1ST – Civil War Token, Fuld MI 920A-1b
- 2ND – 1925 Fort Vancouver Centennial commemorative
- 3RD – Civil War Token, Fuld PA 750P-1a (NGC MS64)

CLASS 4 – FOREIGN AND ANCIENT COINS

- 1ST – 1892 50c Italy (KM #26)
- 2ND – 1787 Columbia gold coin
- 3RD – 1895 South Africa gold coin

CLASS 5 – ERRORS

- 1ST – No date 90% brockage and large broadstrike 1c (PCGS MS65RB)
- 2ND – 1966 25c struck on 5c planchet (AU 55)
- 3RD – 2002 Mississippi 25c missing clad layer

- 1ST – 1928 Standing Liberty 25c
- 2ND – 1875-S US 20c
- 3RD – 1909-S Lincoln cent

SENIOR YNs

- 1ST – 1752 Venice gold coin
- 2ND – 1937 Roanoke half dollar
- 3RD – 1914-D Lincoln cent

JUNIOR YNs

- 1ST – 10-oz .999 fine silver bar
- 2ND – 1875 20c US coin
- 3RD – 1909-S US Lincoln cent
