

Public Registration Chairman's Report

Public Registration for FUN 2012 went very smoothly. Although FUN hadn't been held in the South hall of the "new" section of the Orange County Convention Center before, the signage helped everyone find their way to the show. The OCCC illuminated signs worked well, and FUN also hung a huge sign reading "Coin Show" on the outside of the building. A free shuttle bus provided by FUN took attendees to and from the convention hotels. FUN also arranged a lower parking fee, which was a pleasant surprise for our attendees.

The Central Florida Coin Club provided volunteers to work public registration for the show. A total of 36 individuals came for at least one shift, and some worked multiple shifts. As to attendance, it was incredibly strong. We gave out 8,000 name tags, but that underestimates attendance; many people saved their badges from day to day in order to avoid going through registration again. A good estimate of total attendance is 11,000 to 12,000. We've never had a show where public registration was as busy.
